Centennial Park Skating Club is a non-profit organization that is operated by a group of parent volunteers under the sanction of Skate Canada. **Our professional coaches are Skate Canada certified, hold a valid FIRST AID CERTIFICATE and have undergone a POLICE BACKGROUND CHECK.** A description of our Skate Canada programs, schedule and rates is outlined herein. The Board of Directors reserves the right to alter the schedule and available programs pending registration needs. Classes of less than 5 skaters will not be permitted. Full payment can be made at registration or divided into 2 equal payments, second payable December 1st, 2010 (by post-dated cheques only). Fees are payable by Cheque or Cash Only. Kindly make cheques payable to C.P.S.C. Please bring your skater's Health Card & Skate Canada Number when you register. For any questions or concerns, contact our office located at Centennial Arena, 2nd floor, East Lounge.

PreCanSkate

Fully supervised 30-minute learn-to-skate session for children 3 years old as of Sept 1, 2010. Balls, toys, games and songs are used to make learning fun. C.S.A. approved helmets and mittens are mandatory. Ratio is 8 skaters per coach with mature Program Assistants.

CanSkate

Fully supervised 60-minute learn-to-skate program for children 5 years old and up, Teens and Adults. It includes a group lesson and two skill activity sessions using a large ice surface to build strong skating skills. Badges are awarded to skaters as they progress from CanSkate Stages 1 to 6. C.S.A. approved helmets and mittens are mandatory to Stage 4. Helmets optional (at parent's discretion in writing) from Stage 5 and up.

Advanced CanSkate Excellence (A.C.E.)

This is a program for the enthusiastic skater in CanSkate Stage 4 through Stage 6. The aim is to accelerate and enhance skating skills for those interested in advancing to Junior quickly. The age 7 or older skater must participate in two ACE sessions per week. C.S.A. approved helmets and mittens mandatory for Stage 4. Helmets optional (at parent's discretion in writing) from Stage 5 and up.

Days Offered ≈ Monday & Friday \$850

Junior

For CanSkate or ACE skaters who have passed CanSkate Stage 6. Skaters will participate in a 10-minute group stroking lesson and a 15-minute lesson on spins, jumps, field movements and dance. A private coached lesson is mandatory for skaters at this level. Proper skating attire required (i.e. skirt, dress or leggings).

Intermediate

Skaters at this STARSkate level must have passed **two** of the following three categories: 1)Preliminary Dances, 2)Preliminary Skills, 3)Preliminary FreeSkate, Parts 1 & 2. Each session has a 10-minute group stroking lesson. A private coached lesson is mandatory for skaters at this level. Proper skating attire required.

Senior

Skaters at this STARSkate level must have passed **two** of the following three categories: 1)Senior Bronze Dances, 2)Senior Bronze Skills, 3)Junior Bronze FreeSkate, Parts 1 & 2. Each session has a 10-minute group stroking lesson. A private coached lesson is mandatory for skaters at this level. Proper skating attire required.

Off - Ice Sessions

Off-ice training is offered to STARSkate skaters to strengthen and develop the fundamentals of jumps, spins, body awareness, presentation and endurance. Two-day members are entitled to one off-ice session per week as part of their program. Please refer to the schedule for your appropriate session.

Skaters will be taught to perform a group showcase number for entry into Thornhill Fun Competition.

Volunteer Assistance

is required from all parents to facilitate the operation of this non-profit skating club. Parents of Junior, Intermediate, and Senior skaters are asked to complete 25 hours of assistance while parents of PreCanSkate and CanSkate skaters are asked for 5 hours. A \$200.00 post-dated cheque is required upon registration for Junior, Intermediate, and Senior skaters. Upon completion of your mandatory 25 hours of volunteer assistance, your cheque will be returned to you. Your support is much appreciated!

Child Fitness Tax Credit The Government of Canada allows a non-refundable tax credit on eligible amounts of up to \$500.00 paid by parents to register a child under 16 in an eligible program of physical activity. All fees quoted include ice rental, group coaching, Skate Canada fee, Fundraising fee, administration and off-ice where applicable. Families of 3 or more receive a \$100.00 discount. All family members must be from the same household.

Refund Policy 50% of remaining ice fees will be reimbursed at month end. No refund for Skate Canada, Administration & Fundraising fees. A \$30.00 service charge will be levied for any cheques returned for Non Sufficient Funds (NSF).

Ticket Ice \$20 per session, subject to availability.
